

## **NHOA Common Areas**

1. All members in good standing and their designees may use all areas of common ground.
  - A. Parks – 2 parks on lake Nocona with boat ramps and fishing areas, (Texas fishing license is required), 1 park on leisure lake with fishing access, (no fishing license is required) and boat launching area that is restricted (no gasoline motorized boats or motorized watercraft), all paddle boats, kayak, canoe and john boats are allowed, boats with trolling motor only are also allowed, swimming in leisure lake is not recommended due to silt and brush. Camping only allowed in designated campground.
  - B. Campgrounds—travel trailer hook ups are available for NHOA members in good standing by appointments or reservations. W/ water and elect, sewage dump is available at entrance to campgrounds. Time of stay is limited. Guests or family of members in good standing may also be acquired at minimal cost and w/limited times of stay. Public may with reservation also acquire camping spots with set rate and limited time of stay. All access must be acquired through NHOA office and is on first come first serve basis. Fishing access is available and overnight tent camping spots are available. Picnic area is available at all times and on first come first serve basis.

### **Hunting**

2. Hunting is not allowed inside Nocona hills, this is a residential community with close proximity housing, discharging a firearm is only allowed under emergency circumstances for protection from varmints such as skunks (possible rabies), venomous snakes, coyotes that are after pets, wild hogs that pose a intimate threat to your safety. No target practicing is allowed.
